## THE CURATE WRITES ....

On 3rd July, the Church remembers St. Thomas the Apostle. Thomas is often remembered by the unfortunate nickname "Doubting Thomas". After Jesus' resurrection, Thomas struggled to believe what others were telling him. He wanted evidence. He wanted to see for himself.

Many people can relate to that.

Whether we consider ourselves committed Christians, occasional churchgoers, people of another faith, or simply curious observers, most of us have questions about life. We wonder about purpose, suffering, love, hope and what lies beyond our immediate experience. We may have questions about God, doubts about faith or uncertainties about what we believe.

Thomas reminds us that questions are not something to be ashamed of. In the Gospel story, Jesus does not reject Thomas for his doubts. Instead, he meets him where he is. Thomas is invited to look, to think, and to discover for himself. His doubts become the starting point of a deeper faith.

That seems an important message for our own time. We live in a world full of strong opinions and quick answers. Yet some of life's most important questions cannot be settled by a brief conversation or an internet search. They require patience, reflection and openness.

Perhaps summer offers a chance for that.

As we enjoy gardens in bloom, walks in the countryside, days by the sea, or simply a quiet cup of tea in the sunshine, we may find opportunities to reflect on the bigger questions. What gives life meaning? What sustains us in difficult times? What kind of people do we want to become? Where do we find hope?

The Christian faith suggests that God is not distant from such questions. Rather, God is present within them, inviting us to seek, to wonder and to discover. Thomas's story reminds us that faith is not the absence of doubt; often it is the courage to continue the journey despite our doubts.

So this July, whatever it might hold, may you find moments of rest, opportunities for reflection and perhaps even a few unexpected discoveries along the way.

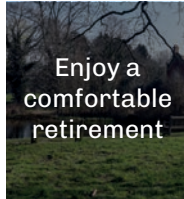

## e-Consult one year on

In July 2025, Whitewater Health launched e-consult; a Total Triage appointment model across Hartley Wintney and Hook surgeries to eliminate the morning telephone lottery. A year on, whilst not perfect, daily clinical capacity has increased and every medical request is reviewed by a clinician, creating a safer and fairer system for 18,000 patients.

### **Why the change?**

Before e-Consult, securing an appointment depended on who could dial fastest at 8:00 am. Now, care is allocated based on medical urgency rather than a first-come, first-served basis and every online submission is clinically triaged by a GP who determines the best course of action- whether its seeing a GP, Clinical Pharmacist, Physiotherapist, or Advanced Nurse Practitioner.

### **Fair access for everyone**

Committed to preventing a digital divide for patients who cannot use a computer or smartphone, the following options are also available:

- **AI Phone Assistant:** A secure system takes symptom details and fills out the form automatically.
- **Language Tools:** The system supports over 30 languages
- **Staff Support:** Patients can call or walk into either surgery, where a receptionist will complete the form on their behalf.

### **How to use eConsult - Step-by-Step**

**The eConsult Portal opens at 8:00am, Monday to Friday, until daily safe capacity is reached.**

- **Visit the Portal:** Go to the Whitewater Health website or open the NHS App.
- **Select your Request:** eg. 'Book Appointment' if you are submitting symptoms
- **Answer the Questions:** Complete online questions about your symptoms or needs
- **Submit:** Your form goes directly to our clinical triage team.
- **Receive a Response:** Medical requests are processed within two working days, administrative queries, Sick/fit notes etc can take up to three working days.

### **Surgery Statistics for April 2026**

- ▶ 3909 total calls handled; 916 managed via the AI Receptionist; 714 Call back requests
- ▶ Average answering time 6 minutes 13 seconds
- ▶ Between 800 and 1000 eConsults submitted each week
- ▶ On average 30-40 eConsults are resolved at point of triage - so no appointment needed saving 1.5 days of appointments per day.
- ▶ 3020 GP appointments and 2083 Nurse appointments were made during April; 68% of them face to face and 13% by phone
- ▶ There were 404 missed appointments in April costing around £12,100.

No system overhaul is without its learning curve and Whitewater Health has actively adjusted eConsult operations based on patient and staff feedback. This work continues.

The minimum grant is £100 and The maximum grant £1000. Grant awards are one-off. Grant applications must demonstrate how the proposed project or initiative supports one or more of Hampshire County Council's four priority commitments in the Strategic Plan:

- Giving your communities the best chance to thrive
- Keeping you, your families and friends safe
- Providing innovative services you need and value.

## **The North Hants National Trust Centre (NHNTC) Visit to Kenwood House**

Thirty members of the NHNTC enjoyed a fascinating and highly informative day visiting this historic neoclassical gem. Its elegant symmetrical facade and sweeping grounds occupy a large area of parkland on the edge of Hampstead Heath. Designed in the 18<sup>th</sup> century it was remodelled by Robert Adams as the home of the Earl of Mansfield. The crown jewel of the house is the magnificent Library, with its ornate, gilded ceilings and semi-circular alcoves that evoke the grandeur of a classical Italian villa.

The contents are just as magnificent with the walls hung with the huge art collection left it by the Guinness family. We were treated with a lecture tour of the house by enthusiastic and knowledgeable guides who showed us “wonderful things”: portraits by Rembrandt, Vermeer, Gainsborough, Reynolds, Romney, Frans Hals, Van Dyke – an arts lover’s heaven!

Outside, we were able to wander around the tranquil, landscaped English Heritage gardens that perfectly frame distant views of the London skyline. We could enjoy the flower gardens, woodland paths and serene ponds which provide a peaceful escape from the bustling city below.

Finally, a few words about William Murray, first Earl of Mansfield and Britain’s Lord Chief Justice for 30 years. He played a pivotal role in the abolition of the slave trade. In the landmark 1772 Somerset case, Mansfield famously declared slavery “so odious” that it could not exist under English common law. The daughter of his nephew was just as famous. Dido Belle was the offspring of the nephew’s affair with an enslaved African woman. She was adopted by Mansfield and became the first British aristocrat of colour – you may have seen the 2013 film “Belle” which tells the story of her upbringing at Kenwood.

## CONTACT - YOUR LOCAL MAGAZINE

Although this magazine drops through every letter box in the parish of Hartley Wintney, this does not happen by magic. It involves a large team of volunteers from the two joint editors to the proof readers, contributors, advertisers, printers, couriers and deliverers. Currently there are two joint editors, Jane Woods and Diana Harvey. Jane has been editor for many years but will be stepping down later this year. A few years ago, following an appeal in church, together with Jane, Diana became joint editor, having stepped down from Hartley Wintney Parish Council and looking for something to do. A couple of years ago, she added being Chair of Contact when Mike Sisson retired from the position.

When Contact began, everything was paper based and produced on a Roneo machine (these pre-dated modern photocopiers and were frequently hand cranked). It was paid for by subscription and had limited readership. It was a previous vicar, Piers Warburton, who decided to make it a free publication, delivered to every household and paid for by advertising. Contact is now delivered monthly to approximately 4,000 houses.

Each edition takes a month to produce, articles are sent to the editors (Jane and Diana do six months each per year) who fit them into the template for the magazine. Articles from the churches are always towards the front of the magazine and often the centre pages are given over to an interview by Irene Airton with someone who plays a particular role in the community or who has achieved something of interest either currently or in their past. The cover page is usually from one of the many talented photographers in the village who send in photos, primarily of local scenes.

The editors sometimes describe Contact as a bit of a jigsaw trying to arrange all the articles that are sent in each month. As with all publications, articles may sometimes be tweaked to fit the space available. When the edition is ready, a paper copy (so that they make notes) is sent to the proof readers. There is currently a team of six proof readers and each month two of them check the first draft, looking for spelling mistakes, dates that don't match up, problems with layout etc. It is a task requiring a lot of concentration. When the first proof reader has gone through the magazine, they send it to the second one for re-checking, and when that is done, it is returned to the editor who makes the corrections. It is then ready to be sent to the printer. The print run each month is approximately 4000 copies.

When the printed magazines arrive back, they are sorted by a team of 9 sorters who count them out into boxes for the team of 12 couriers to deliver to the approximately 131 deliverers who then post them through your door, (two of the team are both courier and deliverer). All in all, this totals around 150 people who are involved at this point in the operation.

Advertisers are essential for Contact as they allow it to be provided without charge. Most of the advertisers are local and many people turn to them first to look for services because they feel they can trust them. For people new to the village it's a good way of finding out about what's available locally.

As with many organisations, Contact is in DESPERATE need of more volunteers; many of the team have done the job for years and are now finding that they are ready to hand on the baton to younger people. In particular, with Jane stepping down this year, a co-editor is needed, so if someone out there has a passion for the magazine and is interested in bringing together the content, Contact would love to hear from you. The software used is Canva, so if you're familiar with it or are happy to learn that would be great, but above all enthusiasm and creativity are what's needed.

Another role that would not make too many demands on a busy person is that of Committee member with no specific role. There is only one committee meeting per year and on rare occasions a committee member might be asked to cover for a courier or deliverer. This might suit someone with limited time. Of course, new volunteers to courier and deliver are always welcome and this would only take up around an hour a month.

There are plans to launch a digital version of Contact which would reach a wider audience and allow those who move away from the village to keep in touch (currently, when requested, Contact is posted). However, a printed version will always be available.

However, none of this will happen if Contact runs out of volunteers and currently there is a very serious risk of that happening. So if we want Contact to continue, rather like shopping in the High Street, if we don't use it we'll lose it. If more people can spare just a very few hours a month, Contact will hopefully go on from strength to strength. Contact is possibly the largest single team of volunteers working together in our community. Contact survived Covid and was the only local magazine that kept going at the time. Hopefully it can survive now and thrive with a new influx of people to the team.

## A July Update from Jess, the HW Countryside Ranger

The teasels are coming out at the moment, particularly near the noticeboard. I love how the leaves of teasels form little basins that collect dew and rainwater, providing a handy drinking source for birds and insects. When they flower, teasels are especially popular with butterflies and bees, and later, when they go to seed, they provide a good food source for birds.



Down in the heathland, it was lovely to see some heath bedstraw and a few heath spotted-orchids in bloom.

Many who attended last year's training sessions said that afterwards they felt more comfortable and confident about trying to help someone in need. They also appreciated the friendly atmosphere and the chance to ask questions or raise concerns about knowing what to do.

### What's Been Happening

At our latest free Prostate Cancer Screening, 234 men were tested with 185 testing Green, 25 testing Amber and 24 testing Red. Even if men test Amber or Red it does not mean they have prostate cancer; it means further investigation may be needed.

We thank the men who came to be tested and all the people helping including those from The Graham Fulford Charitable Trust, the Odiham Cottage Hospital, Friends of Lions and the North Hampshire Prostate Cancer Support Group who were there to talk with men as they left and, more importantly, are there to offer support to men testing Amber or Red. A future screening is planned for this coming November.

Before going away with Sophie and her family for half-term Andrew needed to treat the wheat against various disease risks due to the wet, warm weather and managed to do so around the showers. The next round is due this week and the downpours are proving difficult, but it needs doing before we go away again after the weekend.

Our week with the family on Exmoor was the best. Exmoor is a longstanding haunt of our family, with many many weeks spent there over the years, but even in summer we have never experienced such hot, cloudless days where river swimming was an essential activity! The children loved doing the things that their mother enjoyed as a child, and loved Mr Styles and his ice-cream van! We hadn't been there for about four years and there is a marked change in the landscape with very little livestock, which is having a significant effect on the vegetation along with increased fire risk.

Interestingly, on last week's Countryfile programme there was a section about the reintroduction of cattle onto moorland in Scotland. The reasoning is that the animals will graze, and tread old vegetation down thus promoting fresh growth and so reduce the fire risk. It should also increase biodiversity as seen in an experiment on the Holkham Estate where cattle were reintroduced onto water meadows.

The current heavy rain is proving a Godsend for arable growers. Three weeks ago a friend of ours told us that his winter barley was beginning to die through drought, and we saw several fields on our travels up and down the A303 that were showing the same signs. However, wheat crops should be saved for the time being, but with margin for grain crops so thin it is heartbreaking to watch your work literally wither.

Unlike domestic supplies, we have just renewed our water contract. The good news is that the supplier we use has human beings on the end of the phone without an endless menu of options first, but the less good news is that the rates are inevitably not cheaper than the last contract!

However, having noticed some added equipment in the pit where our meter is we learned that it is a signalling thing so the meter can be read on a drive by!! How times change.

The dogs have been reasonably good. We had Hogarth the Pug staying for a week and once again his bed was vandalised, thus new cushions to go in the bottom of it were bought again. I have suggested for the future that Hogarth travels without his bed, which should save me a few pennies and reduce the irritation of clearing up a hollowfibre storm that covers an awful lot of ground!

Finally, though, thank you to anyone who voted in the final of Britain's Got Talent. A great result for the Hawkstone Choir made up of farming folk from across the country giving our industry some high-profile publicity.
